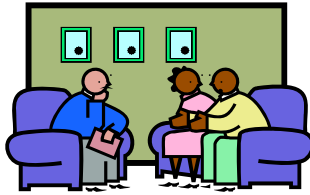


Practical Techniques for Family Counseling

Dr. Robinson is the Vice President of Academic Affairs and Assistant Professor at the American School of Professional Psychology at Argosy University, Schaumburg Campus. Previous appointments have included Assistant Professor of Counseling and Human Services at Roosevelt University and an Adjunct Professor at the Adler School of Professional Psychology. Dr. Robinson received his Psy.D. in clinical psychology from the Adler School of Professional Psychology in Chicago, Illinois. Dr. Robinson also has advanced training in clinical hypnosis, cognitive-behavior therapy, rational emotive behavior therapy and Adlerian psychology, and is active in several national and local professional organizations. In addition, to his academic appointment he maintains an active private practice in Orland Park, Illinois and is on Staff at Provena Mercy Center in Aurora, Illinois.
